## Dear Parents.

After an amazing year of achievement for Latchmere chess pupils we are again offering a Y3-Y6 After School session and Y3-Y4 and Y5-Y6 Lunchtime sessions. With limited places available, After School is for intermediate/advanced players only. Lunchtime sessions are open to pupils of any standard including complete beginners on a first-come-first-served basis.

Chess is a fun game. It improves concentration, memory, cognitive thinking and calculating ability. It also develops analytical skills, training the mind to plan ahead.

## We play and learn about strategy and tactics together

Although fun, it is not just about winning. They will learn from their losses and become more **resilient** and how to stay **calm under pressure**. You will see them grow in confidence as they progress. **Last year, several players were selected for Surrey!** 

This Autumn Term all children will be prepared for the popular UK Chess Challenge (70,000 kids nationwide take part!) which starts in the Spring Term. This year Latchmere achieved 10 Giga Finalists. We became the first ever State Primary to become National Schools Girls Team Finalists. Five Latchmere pupils represented Surrey in U11 County Finals!

My name is Mark Hogarth, I am a very experienced Chess teacher, Junior Chess County selector, England International and qualified Chess Arbiter. Complete beginners are taught from scratch until they are ready to be assimilated into the main group which covers Openings/middlegame strategy/basic endgames & checkmating patterns.

Whilst working at Credit Suisse First Boston I also successfully pioneered Chess Partners as part of the Tower Hamlets Education Business Partnership a Charity, teaching Primary School kids in London's East End.

Cost for the Term is **£70 for lunch time**, **£88 for After School**. If you are in receipt of free school meals then chess is **free**.
